

WHAT IS THE SRC?

The Southern Regional Committee (SRC) is a Standing Committee of the California Water Environment Association. **The purpose is to provide direction, resources, and communication between the Southern Sections/Committees and the CWEA Board of Directors.** The SRC coordinates and serves as a resource for region wide activities including training conferences and TCP test preparation classes.

The SRC represents all Southern Regional Sections of the CWEA. These Southern Local Sections (LS) are:

Colorado River Basin (CORBS)
Desert and Mountain (DAMS)
Golden Empire (GES)
Los Angeles Basin (LABS)
Santa Ana River Basin (SARBS)
San Diego (SDS)
Tri-Counties (TRI)

Membership:

- The membership of the SRC is comprised of two designated representatives of each LS and the Officers of the SRC.
- One LS representative should be the Chair (or President), and the other is typically the Vice-President.
- If the LS representative is not available for the SRC meeting, a proxy can be sent.
- LS representation is **required** at each SRC meeting

SRC Officers:

- The officers of the SRC shall be the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Past Chair, Secretary and Technical Certification Program Liaison.
- Each term of office shall be two years.
- Candidates for Secretary and Vice-Chair shall be nominated at-large. The incumbent Vice-Chairperson shall be appointed to the Chair.
- Upon vacancy of any office, an election to fill the un-expired term shall be held at the next scheduled committee meeting.

Meetings:

- The SRC meets a minimum of 4 times a year. The locations of the meetings are as follows:
 - Q1: at the location of the CWEA Southern Regional Conference, typically near San Diego
 - Q2: At the location of the CWEA Annual Conference
 - Q3 & Q4: moves throughout the region
- Meetings are open to all interested persons

Voting:

- A minimum of 4 LS must be represented to vote on items at the meeting. If LS representation is not met, votes can be differed to a telephone conference. Only members of SRC can vote.

Finances:

- Expenses for the SRC are met from funds from the CWEA annual Budget
